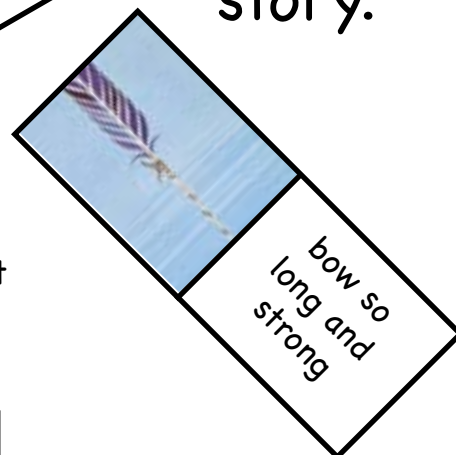
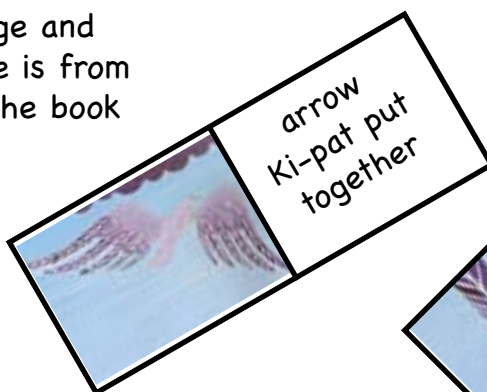


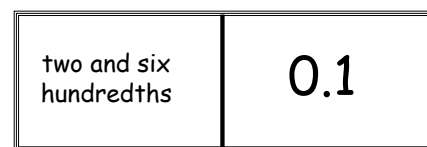
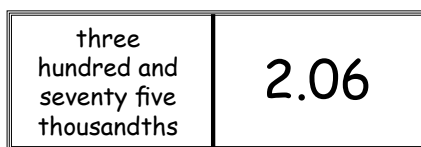
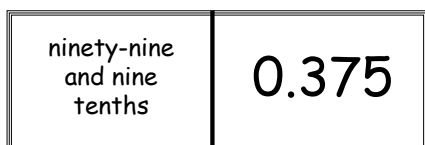
Dominoes Activities

You can find a lot of collaborative activities using dominoes across the age range and in every subject area. This example is from our Early Years activity based on the book "Bringing the Rain to Kapiti Plain"

Children can match picture and text to build up the story.



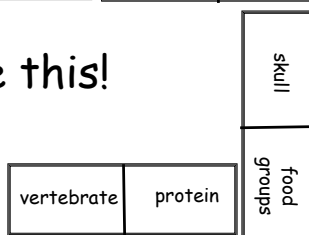
Here is a domino activity involving matching different ways of expressing decimals.



Animal Life Dominoes



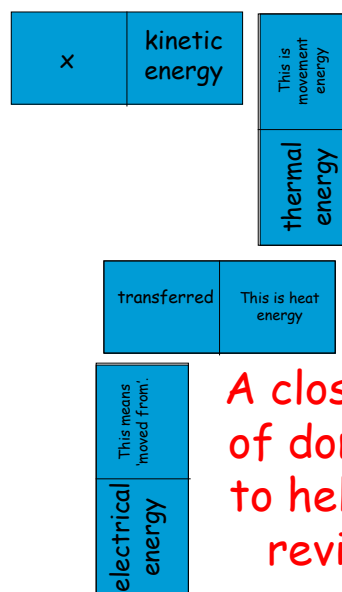
...like this!



Cut out the dominoes. Try to match the Key Words to make the longest line of dominoes (e.g. "bacteria" can go with "digestive system"). There are lots of possibilities and patterns (e.g. "heart" goes with "muscle", "veins and arteries", "blood" etc. Players must agree on the links. Winner is the one to get rid of most of their dominoes!

We have also found that "open ended dominoes", where there is more than one possible matching and where pupils have to argue their case for placing their domino, very good for stimulating fruitful classroom talk.
