OUR APPROACH

Our safeguards connect day-to-day working practices with the responsibilities schools and organisations expect from an education technology provider.

01	Secure by practice Role-based access, strong authentication, current software, secure data transfer and regular staff awareness all form part of our security approach.
02	Privacy with clear roles Our data-protection documents explain what information is used, why it is needed and how responsibilities are shared with schools and organisations.
03	AI with human oversight AI-assisted features are supported by filtering, clear user information, human review where appropriate and routes for reporting concerns.

SECURITY OVERVIEW

How we protect information

Across Cultures uses technical and organisational measures to protect the confidentiality, integrity and availability of information across our services.

Safeguard	How it is applied
Secure hosting and transfer	Our platforms use secure cloud infrastructure. Learning Village data is hosted using Amazon Web Services in the UK and Ireland, and data in transit is protected using HTTPS/TLS. Continued....



Controlled access	Access is role-based and follows least-privilege principles. Accounts are unique, strong authentication is required, multi-factor authentication is used where available, and access is removed when no longer needed.
Current and monitored systems	Supported software, security updates, firewalls, monitoring and regular vulnerability checks help protect our websites, applications and devices.
People and service providers	Staff and authorised users have confidentiality and security responsibilities, receive appropriate awareness training, and must report concerns. Relevant service providers are reviewed and contractually required to protect data.
Responsible data handling	We limit collection to information needed to provide the service. Data is retained, protected and securely deleted or anonymised in line with our agreements and legal responsibilities.
Incident response	Suspected incidents are reported, contained, assessed and documented. Schools, affected individuals and regulators are notified where required, followed by a review to reduce the risk of recurrence.

How we protect information

Schools and educational organisations: For learner data, the school or educational organisation decides why and how the information is used and acts as the data controller.

Across Cultures: We process that information on the organisation's behalf and act as the data processor. Our Data Processing Agreement explains the responsibilities of each party.

We maintain internal operational policies supporting secure delivery. Relevant documents or supporting information can be provided to existing and prospective customers, where appropriate, for procurement, data-protection and security-assurance purposes.
