Levels of Learning Village Support:

1. Beginning: learner-directed sessions

- Learners learn how to learn
- School time assigned to the Learning Village
- Use of Learning Village Book of Progress

3. Mastering: learner- and teacher-directed sessions and customisation to suit your curriculum

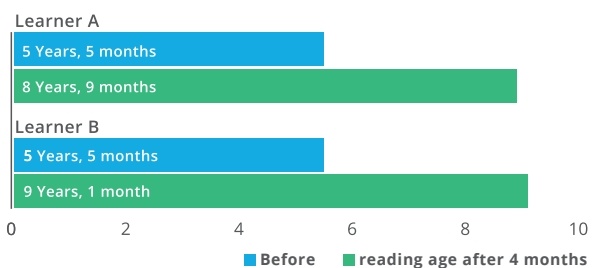

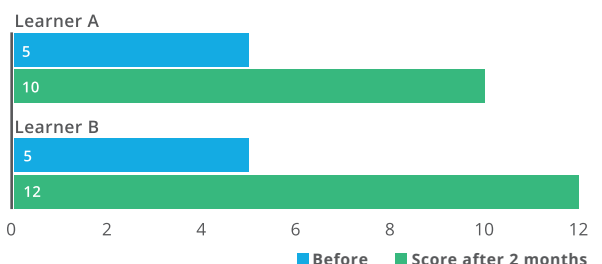
An 8-year-old EAL learner's reading comprehension age after 4 months of using the Learning Village.

AssessEP is a robust and comprehensive English proficiency assessment tool designed for English language learners aged 7+ through to adults. It is easy to administer and covers all four language skills (reading, writing, speaking, and listening) with embedded grammar and vocabulary questions. An approximate alignment to BELL, CEFR, ELLP and other EAL curricula is provided.

AssessEP can be used for:

- initial placement testing
- generation of learner profiles
- admissions testing
- summative assessment over time
- identifying disparities across different skills
- informing planning and provision

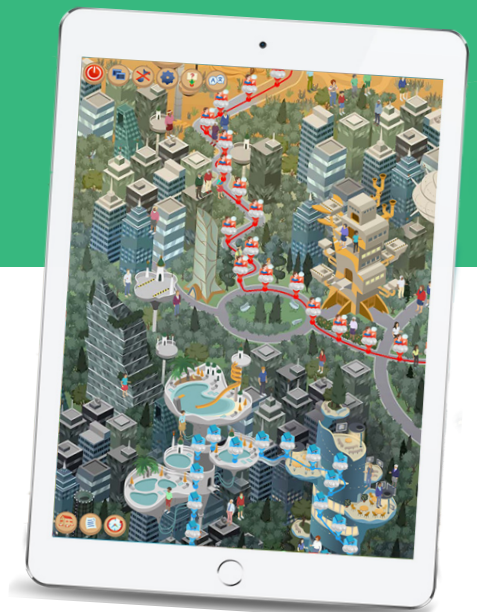
